Please note that MHSAA and Volleyball Canada has issued a on-court warmup routine that **we will be following at this tournament. It will be good/necessary practice for our school MCI teams, since they have to use it during all tournaments, regular season, and playoffs. **

- Basically, teams will be given separate warmup times for hitting, with the other team on the sideline, and out of the way.
- In addition, athletes are not allowed to go under the net to the other side during the hitting practice, to retrieve their volleyball. They need to go around the court on the outside of the posts and outside the end lines.

- **This is now done to cut down on concussions and injuries, since many players are not expecting random volleyballs travelling towards them on the court.**

Tournament Format

- **Round robin:** 2 games to 25 (1-point advantage)
- **Playoff round:** Best 2/3 with (2-point advantage)
- Please be ready to play if games finish early and be ready to go without an on-court warm up **after your first game** to keep the tournament running as quick and efficient as possible.
- Each team is guaranteed 4 games for Men's with a max of 5 games.
- Each team is guaranteed 4 games for Women's with a max of 5 games.

- **Women's Draw:** Team records tallied by **NUMBER OF SETS WON** throughout the round robin.

- **Men's Draw:** Team records tallied by **NUMBER OF SETS WON** throughout the round robin.

Tiebreakers:

- Tiebreaker 1: Who won head to head matchup **between tied teams**
- Tiebreaker 2: Team with best ratio of points for/against within **ALL** pool games they played in round robin.
- Tiebreaker 3: Rock, Paper, Scissors - best 2 out of 3
