



Student Fundraising Information 2024/2025

Each year MCI students are given the opportunity to fundraise for designated school trips being planned for that year and/or for future years. Money raised through fundraisers is held in the student council account and is specific to the student who has done the fundraising. The amounts raised by each individual student can be held over grade years—so that a student in grade 9 can already be fundraising for a school trip in grade 12, for example.

There are typically four to six fundraisers throughout a school year. In the past, these have included Spent Bros., Southern Meats, Sun Valley Coop gift cards, Winkler Coop gift cards, etc

Money raised through a fundraiser at MCI can be used for school specific trips—these include Europe Trip, Grad Trip, Choir Tours, SOAR Missions trip. The money raised **cannot** be used to pay for any MCI school fees.

If, when a student graduates or withdraws, there is fundraising money remaining unused in their student fundraising account, that money can be passed on to a sibling/cousin/friend to use for specific school trips. This money **cannot** be cashed out or used to pay for school fees.

We encourage students to take part in these fundraisers—it is a great way to earn money for school trips and be involved in school life. Information about the fundraisers is given to students at daily announcements, to families in the weekly family email, and on the MCI website.
